



Evening drive June 5th 2018 from The Sotted Cow to The Hinds Head, **Bucks Head Hill, Meonstoke,**

Leaving the Spotted Cow turn left and follow the road over the small mini roundabout and first exit on the next round about heading towards Chichester A27. At the main roundabout follow the A27 Westbound for Portsmouth.

Go straight across the next roundabout. At the following roundabout take the first exit, marked Fishbourne and the Roman Palace.

Follow the Bosham road, past the Woolpack and Bulls Head pubs. Just after the pub take a right turn 'Salthill Road', marked for the Roman Palace.

Follow the road over the rail crossing and over the A27. At the 'T' Junction turn left and head towards 'East Ashling' and 'Funtington'.

Continue through both villages, heading towards 'Rowlands Castle'.

Stay on the road passing the Navel communications establishment and continue till you reach a 'T' junction and turn right. Note: this is a dual carriageway road and you will need to filter in.

Follow the B2148 heading to 'Rowlands Castle'

At the next roundabout take a right turn (This is a double roundabout, so second exit and first exit, results in a right turn.) heading towards London A3 and Horndean B2149.

Continue the B2149 into Horndean.

As you reach the next roundabout, take the second exit A3 Petersfield.

Follow the road as it passes under the A3(M).

Continue as the road runs along by the A3(M).

The road turns to the left and continues through Clanfield and over the next mini roundabout.

At the next Junction, is a staggered cross road, turn right and immediately left to continue straight on.

At the next 'T' junction turn left Hambledon and Denmead. (East Street)

Continue for about 2miles, then take a right turn for 'Droxford'.

At the next 'T' Junction, turn right Droxford B1250.

At the next 'T' junction turn right, A32 Corhampton

You will see a signpost for a main roundabout Alton and Bishops Waltham, 100mts after there is a right turn marked 'Meonstoke'.

As you pass over the river Meon the Hinds Head is on the left.
