

Route for club night run on Tuesday 3rd of July 2018 to The White Horse at Graffham (GU28 0NT)

Total distance: 17.9 miles

Total journey time: approx 35 minutes

Departure time from The Spotted Cow: **19:30**

This is merely a recommended route. There is strictly no competition in this road run. There are no prizes for coming first.

<b>TURN LEFT</b> out of the Spotted Cow car park (PO20 1PD).
Go <b>STRAIGHT ON</b> at the mini roundabout.
Take the <b>2nd EXIT</b> (turn right) at the next roundabout onto the B2166 for North Mundham, Pagham.
Go <b>STRAIGHT ON</b> at the mini roundabout, passing The Walnut Tree pub on your left.
Just 400 yards after the mini roundabout <b>TURN LEFT</b> into Marsh Lane. (Beware of road works, potholes, a ditch to your nearside, tight bends, and oncoming vehicles in the middle of the road).
<b>TURN LEFT</b> at the T junction at the end of the lane to join the A259, signposted for Chichester.
Just 200 yards later take the <b>3rd EXIT</b> at the roundabout, signposted Drayton, Oving B2144.
Continue over the rail crossing on the B2144.
<b>TURN RIGHT</b> at the T junction, signposted for Tangmere and Military Aviation Museum.
Pass the Tangmere Aviation museum on your right, following the road as it bends sharply left.
550 yards after the museum <b>TURN RIGHT</b> into Meadow Way, signposted Boxgrove, Chichester, Worthing A27.
Take the <b>2<sup>nd</sup> EXIT</b> at the roundabout, signposted Boxgrove & Priory, Halnaker.
<b>TURN RIGHT</b> at the crossroads, signposted Duncton, Petworth.
Follow the A285 through Halnaker and Upwaltham.
Descend a steep hill (Duncton Hill). Beware very sharp bends at bottom of hill.
Pass The Cricketers Pub on the right. The road straightens ahead.
<b>TURN LEFT</b> approx 0.9 of a mile after the Cricketers pub, signposted Selham, Graffham.
After 1.4 miles <b>TURN LEFT</b> at crossroads, signposted Graffham, Caravan Site.
Enter Graffham village.
<b>TURN RIGHT</b> just after The Foresters Arms pub on the left.
<b>TURN LEFT</b> 275 yards after the junction, into The 'White Horse' pub car park
