Chichester MGOC 1006 Club Rules

- 1. Members should seek to enhance the reputation of the club and not do anything to bring the club into disrepute.
- 2. Members at all times should act in a civil way towards other members and the public. Bad behaviour will not be tolerated.
- In dealing with 3rd parties, only members of the Club Committee can say they represent the Club unless the Chairman gives approval.
- 4. Members who incur expenses, dealing with club matters, are entitled to claim reasonable costs, redeemable from the Treasurer.
- 5. Expenditure or contracts over £100 need the approval of the Club Chairman and Treasurer.

When attending a Club meeting or event, the following rules apply:

- 6. All members must obey the Highway Code and speed limits.
- 7. When arriving or leaving venues avoid excessive noise and act responsibly.
- 8. Members cars must be roadworthy and have a current MOT if required by law.
- 9. Members cars must have the minimum 3rd party insurance

Disciplinary Procedure

- 1. Any member who is in serious or persistent breach of the Rules or who acts in a way which is inappropriate may be required by the Committee to attend for a hearing to explain his or her conduct.
- 2. All complaints regarding the behaviour of members should be presented and submitted in writing to the Club Chairman.
- 3. The Committee will meet to hear complaints within 14 days of a complaint being lodged. The Committee has the power to take appropriate disciplinary action including the termination of membership.
- 4. The outcome of a disciplinary hearing should be notified in writing to the person who lodged the complaint and the member against whom the complaint was made within 7 days of the hearing.
- 5. There will be the right of appeal to the Committee following disciplinary action being announced. The Chairman will nominate an Appeal Committee of three persons including one member of the Club Steering Group. They will consider the appeal within 14 days of the Chairman receiving the appeal. The appeal decision should be notified to both parties within 7 days. The decision of the Appeal Committee is final.
